To whom it may concern,

**Subject**: Mandatory minimum requirements for certification of ratings forming part of a navigational watch and ratings forming part of an engineering watch, who followed a STCW modular course.

- 1. Mandatory minimum requirements for certification of **ratings forming part of a navigational watch** on a seagoing ship of 500GT or more, who followed a modular course II/4:
  - Certificate of a **course** II/4 (\*) accredited by the Belgian Maritime Administration;
  - Approved seagoing service of not less than 2 months with a Cadet Training Record Book (CTRB for rating deck). The approved seagoing service shall start after the course II/4.
    At least one month of the 2 months required seagoing service has to be served on a seagoing ship of 500GT or more (and maximum one month on a seagoing ship of less than 500GT).
    As an alternative, 6 months of seagoing service without a CTRB. The same principle is applicable that at least 50% of the seagoing service must be performed on a ship of 500GT or more.
- 2. Mandatory minimum requirements for certification of **ratings forming part of an engineering** watch on a seagoing ship powered by main propulsion of 750kW or more, who followed a modular course III/4:
  - Certificate of a **course** III/4 (\*) accredited by the Belgian Maritime Administration;
  - Approved seagoing service of not less than 2 months with a Cadet Training Record Book (CTRB for ratings engine). The approved seagoing service shall start after the course III/4.
     At least one month of the 2 months required seagoing service has to be served on a seagoing ship with a propulsion power of 750kW or more (and maximum one month on a seagoing ship with a propulsion power of less than 750kW).
    - As an **alternative**, 6 months of seagoing service without a CTRB. The same principle is applicable that at least 50% of the seagoing service must be performed on a ship with a propulsion power of 750kW or more.
